

How the Hall is Run in a Nutshell

The hall is a charity run by volunteers who form a committee of Trustees, some elected by the groups which use the hall (preschool, WI, church, and the Parish Council), and some who are elected by the villagers.

There are only 7 volunteers on the committee. We try to do all we can for community orientated groups and individuals.

We have to raise funds to run the hall, either by hire charges and / or by fundraising events. This is our only form of income apart from any grants we are awarded from time to time.

The hall is not funded by Dover District Council or the Parish Council.

We have special rates for other charities who wish to use the hall for their own fundraising events. Much as we would like to offer the hall for free, one charity should not be out of pocket at the expense of another!

It costs us about £7.50 an hour to run the hall.

The Trustees have the responsibility to keep the hall in reasonably good order, and in the black financially.

Our bank balance is always in need of funds!
